Fredrick Pieper is an executive at Idaho National Laboratory, leading the Internal Audit and Workplace Concerns program. As the Chief Audit Executive, Mr. Pieper has responsibility to provide senior management and Battelle Energy Alliance’s Board of Managers with objective and independent assurance regarding the effectiveness of risk management, internal controls, and governance processes. He manages investigative activities through INL’s Employee Concerns program.

Prior to joining INL in 2009, Mr. Pieper worked for the Department of Energy, Office of Inspector General. During his 18-year career with the Office of Inspector General, he served as the director of the Environmental and Science Audits Division, and was responsible for all program, performance and management control audits for the DOE’s Energy, Science and Environmental operations, managing multiple, regionally dispersed audit groups. He was a member of the U.S. Government Senior Executive Service from June 2005 to February 2009. Prior to his work at the DOE, he was an auditor for the Defense Contract Audit Agency.

Mr. Pieper is a certified public accountant, certified internal auditor, and has a bachelor’s degree in accounting from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas. Mr. Pieper plays an active role in the internal audit profession. He is a frequent presenter at seminars for the Institute of Internal Auditors, has served as the co-chair of the DOE Contractor Internal Audit Directors, and has presented at conferences for the Management Information Systems Training Institute. He is actively involved in his community. He serves as president of the Board of Directors for the Eastern Idaho Community Action Partnership, a nonprofit organization dedicated to helping at-risk individuals and families meet their basic needs and increase independence through support and education. He also has served as a volunteer within the Boy Scouts of America for over 25 years.
