## Hasan Jamil

Dr. Hasan Jamil, originally from Bangladesh, completed his Ph.D. at Concordia University in Montreal, Canada. He has held academic positions in Michigan, Mississippi, Canada and Australia. At the University of Idaho he holds a joint appointment with Idaho National Laboratory. His office is in the Computer Science Department on the Moscow campus.

Hasan's specialty is in databases, knowledge representation and bioinformatics with particular expertise in autonomous data integration and management of large scientific data. He is developing database technologies that can change the way we access, trust, analyze and manage large distributed data and the science that depends on it. Research on smart and collaborative access to data is his current focus. His research in the U.S. has been supported by grants from the National Science Foundation, National Institutes of Health, and U.S. Department of Agriculture, and in Australia by the Australian Research Council. He is also active in disseminating academic research for commercial use and has received NSF Small Business Innovation Research grants to help transfer data integration technologies to practice.
